Bids for the construction of Fire Station No. 6, were opened and referred to the Building Inspector.

The following recommendation of the City Purchasing Agent was adopted by the following Aye vote to-wit; Wright, Rubiola, Steffler.

I herewith submit tabulation of bids for uniforms and caps for Police Department. I recommend that the bid of Kays for supplying the uniforms be accepted, as follows:

Blue Serge, as per sample submitted - - - - - \$23.65 each

Blue Serge Caps, style and quality in use at present - - - \$ 3.15
Grey Serge Caps, same quality as blue, for motorcycle police 3.15

AN ORDINANCE *MI-760*

ACCEPTING PROPOSAL "A" OF MITCHELL CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR GENERAL CONTRACT, PROPOSAL "B" OF BRADEN-HUDSON-WANGLER COMPANY, INCORPORATED, FOR THE PLUMBING AND GAS INSTALLATION, PROPOSAL "C" OF BRADEN-HUDSON-WANGLER COMPANY, INCORPORATED, FOR THE STEAM HEATING SYSTEM INSTALLATION, AND PROPOSAL "D" OF LOYD, PEAL, DITTMAR ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR THE ELECTRICAL WIRING INSTALLATION; AND AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF ARCHITECTS FEES TO JOHN M. MARRIOTT, ARCHITECT; AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$25,306.78 THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the City does hereby accept the attached written proposals of the constructors hereinafter set out, offering to construct and equip Fire Station No. 5, in and for the City of San Antonio; in accordance with the written specifications, descriptions and drawings, prepared and submitted by John M. Marriott, Architect, provided that the Contractors shall strictly comply with all requirements made by or under the provisions of the Ordinances of the City of San Antonio, and all instruments herein mentioned, all of which are made a part hereof.

2. Mitchell Construction Co. as General Contractor - - - - - \$20,695.00

3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to require and to approve on behalf of the City, the proper bonds for the performance and completion of said undertakings.

4. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to cause and require the execution and delivery of written contracts to be drawn in accordance with said proposals, and the terms and conditions understood and required as applicable.

5. That the sum of \$25,306.78, or as much thereof as is necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Police and Fire Building Fund of 1928, to pay the contracts and the architect above named, for the construction of said Fire Station No. 5; the said funds to be paid out as provided by the written contracts; and part of the architect's fees shall be paid as follows:

6. Three and One-Half (3½%) per cent when the plans and specifications are completed and accepted.

7. All other bids are hereby rejected.

AN ORDINANCE *MI-761*

AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING PROPOSAL OF K. G. GRANBERG, GENERAL CONTRACTR, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF FIRE STATION NO. 8; AND APPROPRING \$577.50.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That an ordinance accepting the proposal of K. G. Gramberg, General Contractor, for the construction of Fire Station No. 8, passed and approved on the 3rd day of April, A. D. 1929, be amended by the acceptance of the following alternates:-

3. That the sum of \$27.50 being the amount of the Architect's fee @ 5% of the sum of \$550.00, be and the same is hereby allowed the Architect under his contract.

4. That the sum of \$577.50, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Police & Fire Building Fund of 1928, to pay K. G. Granberg as General Contractor, and Paul G. Silbert as Architect, as per contract on file.
