AN ORDINANCE *MO-547*

ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF MONTEREY IRON & METAL CO. TO PURCHASE
SCRAP IRON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That the proposal of Monterey Iron & Metal Co., of 1124 South Medina Street,

San Antonio, Texas, to purchase scrap iron, for \$215.25, be and the same is accepted hereby.

2. Upon payment of the consideration thereof, the title to the property described in the proposal shall pass to the bidder, and he shall forthwith remove the same from the premises of the City of San Antonio.

3. It is ordered by two-thirds vote of the full Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio that this ordinance shall receive final action without having first been read at three several meetings of the Commission.
