

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

FRIDAY, MARCH 17TH, A. D. 1933, 10:00 A. M.

PRESENT: Honorable Paul E. Steffler, Acting Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Bushick, Rubiola, Wright.

The Clerk read the following call, to-wit: ---

The Acting Mayor announced that nomination for the office of Mayor of the City of San Antonio, to fill out the unexpired term of the late Mayor, C. M. Chambers, were in order.

Commissioner Wright placed in nomination the name of C. K. Quin. The nomination was seconded by Commissioner Bushick, There being no further nominations the Chair directed the Clerk to call the roll, which resulted in the following vote, to-wit; Ayes, Bushick, Rubiola, Steffler, Wright. Nays, none. The Chair then announced that Judge C. K. Quin has been elected to the office of Mayor of the City of San Antonio to fill the vancy caused by the death of Mayor C. M. Chambers.

Whereby the Commissioners adjourned to re-convene at 11:30 o'clock this day.

At the hour of 11:30 this 17th day of March, 1933, the Commissioners met, pursuant to the order of adjournment of a meeting held earlier in the day, the Commissioners met, with Honorable Paul E. Steffler, Acting Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Bushick, Rubiola, Steffler, Wright, present, when Judge W. S. Fly, Chief Justice Court Civil Appeals, 4th Judicial Dist. proceeded to administer the oath of office, to Honorable C. K. Quin, newly appointed Mayor of the City of San Antonio, whereupon the meeting adjourned.
