Invocation by Mayor J. Edwin Kuykendall.

• After the Clerk read the call of the meeting, Mr. Winton asked the Mayor the purpose of the meeting. The Mayor replied that it was called for the good of the city and especially to name a successor to Councilman Gonzalez whose resignation has been accepted.

Mr. Winton then replied that he would like to make a nomination. With brief remarks on the desirability of getting young men on the council he nominated Mr. W. P. Southwell, Jr.

Mr. Crumrine then nominated Dr. Jose San Martin.

The Clerk called the roll and each member designated his choice. The result was:

FOR Mr. Southwell, Mr. Winton;

FOR Dr. San Martin, Friedrich, Baines, Passur, Crumrine, Kuykendall, Olivares, Daniels;

ABSTAINING, Mr. Gonzalez.

Dr. San Martin being the choice of a majority of the council, the Clerk then read the following resolution.

A RESOLUTION

DESIGNATING, APPOINTING AND ELECTING DR. JOSE SAN MARTIN A MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO FOR THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF HENRY B. GONZALEZ, RESIGNED

The resolution was adopted by the following vote: AYES, Friedrich, Baines, Passur, Crumrine, Winton, Kuykendall, Olivares, Daniels; NAYS, none; NOT VOTING, Gonzalez.




