AUTHORIZING THE PROJECT TO EXTEND AND IMPROVE THE SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT AND TO EXTEND THE SEWERAGE COLLECTING SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND FOR THE ALLOCATION OF \$1,600,000.00 BY THE UNITED STATES FOR ITS CONSTRUCTION UNDER THE NIRA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-
