

AN ORDINANCE 2008-05-01-0349

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS, UPON AWARD, NOT TO EXCEED \$800,000.00 FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TXDOT) FOR THE DWI/SPEED ENFORCEMENT SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM (STEP) FOR THE GRANT PERIOD OCTOBER 1, 2008, TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2009; AND AUTHORIZING AN IN-KIND MATCH OF \$258,619.00 AND A CASH MATCH OF \$16,215.00.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has grant funds available for the DWI/Speed Enforcement Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP); and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Police Department wishes to apply for grant funds for that purpose in an amount not to exceed \$800,000.00; and

WHEREAS, award of the grant would require an in-kind match of \$258,619.00 and a cash match of \$16,215.00; and

WHEREAS, the grant period would be October 1, 2008, to September 30, 2009; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to submit a grant application in an amount not to exceed \$800,000.00 to the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) for the DWI/Speed Enforcement Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) for the grant period October 1, 2008, to September 30, 2009. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to accept said grant, if awarded under the same terms and conditions as applied for. The City Manager and her designee are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said application and acceptance.


SECTION 2. Fund 26059000 (Texas Department of Transportation) is hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant. Should funding be awarded, the sum of \$800,000.00 from TxDOT will be appropriated in said fund. A formal final

budget, which will include internal order numbers and general ledger numbers, will be submitted by the San Antonio Police Department upon award.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.






