---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

Citizens, requesting sanitary improvement of Concepcion Creek wa read and referred to Health Department.

Army Y.M.C.A. for permit to erect electric sign at 217 Avenue E. was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police:
Manning B. Pletz, for special building permit.

Oriental Oil Co. for permit to erect gasoline pump and tanks at River Ave & Grayson Sts.

Schroeder Electric Co. for permit to erect ornamental light standæds, 115 Ave C.

Thos Goggan & Bros, for permit to build shed and repair gallery.

Francis T. Brady, for special building permit.

RESOLUTION

Instructing the City Purchasing Agent to advertise for bids on material for streets, sidewalks and concrete bridges.

AN ORDINANCE *MD-268*

Appropriating \$41.31 to pay Mildred Herring, (Minor) for reduction in paving assessment.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$41.31 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to pay Mildred Herring (Minor) on account of reduction of paving assessment on Lot A.20 C.B. 734, as per estimate approved by the City Engineer, on file in the office of City Auditor.

AN ORDINANCE *-269*

Appropriating \$100.00 to pay George R.Karges for land necessary in widening Bowie Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to pay George R.Karges for 1-5/10 ft. off of Lot 83, City Block 153 on the east side of Bowie Street, and for the necessary alterations of gallery and house on the same, and that a warrant issue for that amount payable to the

said George R. Karges upon the execution of a proper deed for same to the City.

AN ORDINANCE *MD-270*

Authorizing the Mayor to release One (1) foot of ground of sewer right-of-way running through the eastern portion of Lots 1 and 6, in Block 1, City Block 1751.

WHEREAS, on the 36th day of March, 1908, J.A.Nix and W.A.Daniel conveyed to the City of San Antonio a sewer right-of-way off the eastern portion of Lots 1 and 6 in Block 1, City Block 1751, as per re-subdivision recorded in Vol. 105, page 123 of the plat records of Bexar County, and

WHEREAS, said easement was accepted by the city on the 27th day of January, 1908 and recorded in Vol. 228, page 283, of the Deed Records of Bexar County; and

WHEREAS in building a house on Lot 1 an error was made and the house was made to extend one foot over the five foot space west of the center of said sewer; and

WHEREAS, Mrs Emma G. Davis, the present owner of the property is willing to deed to the City of San Antonio one foot on the east side of said right of way, allowing the City ingress and egress for the purpose of repairing said sewer, Therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to execute a release to the said owner for the one foot on the west side of the center of said sewer, accepting in lieu thereof one foot on the east side of said sewer right of way.
