THURSDAY, AUGUST 17TH, A. D. 1933, 10:00 A.M.


PRESENT: Honorable C. K. Quin, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Bushick, Steffler, Wright.


Arguments were heard for and against granting the petition and action on the same was postponed until 2. P. M., this date.
