

AN ORDINANCE 2013 - 01 - 10 - 0015

**APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE INNER CITY REINVESTMENT
INFILL POLICY (ICRIP) BOUNDARY.**

* * * * *

WHEREAS, in an effort to promote inner-city growth and economic development, the City Council approved the Inner City Reinvestment Infill Policy (ICRIP) in February 2010; and

WHEREAS, the ICRIP provides for certain fee waivers and other economic incentives in an effort to stimulate economic activity within targeted areas in the City; and

WHEREAS, after an evaluation of the policy, City Council expanded the initial ICRIP boundary in May 2011 to include adjacent areas where economic growth and revitalization are needed, and it is the desire of City Council to once again revise the ICRIP boundary to refine the targeted areas based on a data-driven quality of life index proposed by staff; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves amendments to the ICRIP Boundary as described in **Exhibit A**. Exhibit A shall replace any existing boundary maps and shall serve as the ICRIP Boundary Map from the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by eight (8) affirmative votes and ten (10) days after its passage on fewer than eight (8) affirmative votes.
