Acting Mayor, Phil Wright, introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit; Ayes, Wright, Bushick, Steffler.

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE EMPLOYMENT OF BRUCE W. TEAGARDEN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

SECTION ONE: That the Acting Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute contract of employment with Bruce W. Teagarden, Esq., as follows, to-wit:-

"THE STATE OF TEXAS,  
COUNTY OF BEXAR.

It is agreed between Bruce W. Teagarden and the City of San Antonio:-

1st. That, at the request of the City Attorney, said Teagarden is employed to assist said City in all litigation or present controversies involving the outfall sewer and City's contracts with R. H. Russell and others in reference thereto, and agrees to render his best services in connection therewith, under the supervision and direction of the City Attorney.

2nd. In consideration thereof, said City agrees to pay said Teagarden a total fee of \$1000.00, out of the current fiscal year's revenues, of which the sum of \$500.00 is now paid in cash, as a retainer fee, and if such controversies or litigation result in a trial or trials in court, and appeal, then an additional sum of \$250.00 when said litigation is finally acted and passed on by the Court of Civil Appeals, and the remaining \$250.00 shall be paid when such present controversies are ended; provided, however, that even if such controversies are not then ended, the full amount of \$1000.00, in all shall be paid to him not later than May 31, 1929; and, provided further, that notwithstanding such full amount of \$1000.00 may have been paid before such controversies are ended, said Teagarden shall continue to assist the City and render his best services thereto until such controversies are ended.

Dated this 23rd day of September, A. D. 1927."

SECTION TWO: That in accordance therewith, the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated out of the 1927 General Fund, for the purpose of making payment of the retainer fee therein provided for.
