

AN ORDINANCE 2014 - 06 - 26 - 0515

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF A GIFT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000.00 PROVIDED BY THE SAN ANTONIO PUBLIC LIBRARY FOUNDATION IN SUPPORT OF THE SAN ANTONIO PUBLIC LIBRARY'S NEW TEEN CENTER AT THE CENTRAL LIBRARY, A 2012-2017 GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND FUNDED INITIATIVE.

WHEREAS, the 2012-2017 General Obligation Bond allocated \$4 million for repairs, improvements and enhancements to the Central Library; and

WHEREAS, bond funds have been earmarked to support the relocation of the existing make-shift Teen Center at the Central Library; and

WHEREAS, currently in the design development phase, the new Teen Center will feature technology, activity and training spaces, physical and electronic resources and a homework/work space for teens 13 to 18 years old; and

WHEREAS, the new Teen Center will offer teens aged 13 to 18 an opportunity to be engaged and participate in activities and programs that are educational and transformational in nature; and

WHEREAS, this gift was secured by the San Antonio Public Library Foundation which partners with the San Antonio Public Library to enhance the services and resources of the Library through gifts and donations; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the San Antonio Public Library is authorized to accept and appropriate a gift in the amount of \$50,000.00 provided by the San Antonio Public Library Foundation in support of the San Antonio Public Library's new Teen Center at the Central Library, a 2012-2017 General Obligation Bond funded initiative. The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the San Antonio Public Library is further authorized to execute any necessary documents, after review and approval by the City Attorney or his designee, to complete the acceptance of said gift.

SECTION 2. Funds generated by this ordinance will be deposited into Fund 29804000, Internal Order 804000000093 and General Ledger 4502210.

SECTION 3. The amount of \$50,000.00 is appropriated for this ordinance in Fund 29804000, Internal Order 804000000093 and General Ledger 5501065 and the Fiscal Year 2014 budget is amended to reflect this change.

SECTION 4. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized and should be encumbered with a purchase order.


SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
