

AN ORDINANCE 2011-01-13-0014

**AUTHORIZING A TASK ORDER CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH F.D. CONCRETE, LLC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,100,997.00, TO PERFORM CONSTRUCTION WORK FOR THE RAILROAD QUIET ZONE INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) governs quiet zones and require that a quiet zone be at least one-half mile in length, and to reduce the risk of vehicle accident within these zones, safety measures must be implemented such as concrete medians, conversion of crossings from two-way to one-way traffic, signage and pavement markings installation, installation of four-arm quad gates, or crossing closure; and

**WHEREAS**, this contract is for construction of the infrastructure improvements necessary in order to facilitate the establishment of various quiet zones throughout the City; and

**WHEREAS**, there are seven potential quiet zones being considered throughout the City of which two (2) have been designed and are ready for construction, 1) the Brady Quiet Zone which impacts six (6) crossings and 2) the Frio City Quiet Zone which also impacts six (6) crossings; and

**WHEREAS**, bids were received for the Task Order Contract for Railroad Quiet Zone Infrastructure Improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted and awards a task order construction contract to **F.D. Concrete, LLC** in the amount not to exceed \$1,100,997.00; and

**WHEREAS**, additional quiet zone infrastructure improvements to be completed under this contract will be identified throughout the duration of the contract on an as-needed basis; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The lowest responsive bid of **F.D. Concrete, LLC** in the amount not to exceed \$1,100,997.00 for the Task Order Contract for Railroad Quiet Zone Infrastructure Improvements is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to enter into a Task Order construction contract covering city wide railroad quiet zone infrastructure improvements.

**SECTION 3.** The following financial adjustments are hereby approved:

- a) Funding for this ordinance will be identified when work orders are issued. If funding for any work orders is not previously appropriated, funding will be identified and appropriated through subsequent City Council action. Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with Operating and/or Capital Budgets for current and future fiscal years.
- b) Payment not to exceed \$1,100,997.00 is authorized to be encumbered with a purchase order and made payable to **F.D. Concrete, LLC** for construction services.


**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.


