

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, OCTOBER 21ST, 1915,  
AT FOUR O'CLOCK, P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Albert Steves, Acting Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Garland,  
Lambert and Kearny.

Minutes of the previous meeting were ordered approved.

- - - - - MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS. - - - - -

The petition for the improvement of South Hackberry Street, was read and re-  
ferred to the Commissioner Streets and Public Improvements, Kearny.

The petition of J. M. Allerdyce, for larger water mains in South Laredo Street,  
was read and referred to the Commissioner of Sanitation, Lambert.

The petition for an Arc' Light on the corner of South Mesquite and Dakota Street,  
was read and referred to the Commissioner of Police & Fire, Steves.

On motion duly seconded and carried, the petition of San Antonio Baraca Union  
for permit to erect a tent for revival meetings, was granted.

On recommendation of Dr. W. A. King, City Health Officer, the following peti-

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars additional be and the same is hereby

appropriated out of the 1915 General Fund to defray the expenses of A. J. Goetz, First Assistant Chief of the Fire Department to the New York City Fire College.

Commissioner Kearny recommended that the petition of citizens for bridge across Alazan Creek, be done as soon as funds are available.

Commissioner Kearny recommended that the petition of property owners for relief from storm waters on section bounded by Labor Street, Barrera Street, Hoefgen Avenue and Leigh Street, be done as soon as funds are available for this purpose.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the sum of Four Hundred and Thirty Eight (\$438.84) Dollars and Eighty Four Cents, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1915 General Fund, for the purpose of paying Roach Manigan Paving Company for work done on East Commerce Street, between Alamo Street and Rusk Street.

AN ORDINANCE.

Ordering the laying of sidewalks, etc., on various streets, under the penalties for failure to comply with said order.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

WHEREAS the City Commissioners in the exercise of the Police Power, finds and hereby declares a public necessity for the laying of sidewalks, etc., as hereinafter ordered, and

WHEREAS by an ordinance heretofore on the 10th day of August, A.D., 1914, passed and approved this City Commissioners provided for such cases; said ordinance being entitled "An Ordinance prescribing Specifications for Sidewalks and Curbing for Public Streets and Places, and Providing Measures to Compel the Laying, Construction and Repair of the same by Owners of Abutting Property; Requiring the cost Thereof to be paid by the Owners of such Property and Declaring such cost a personal Liability of such Owners, and a First and Prior Lien and Charge against such Property; and Prescribing the Manner of Ordering and Compelling the Construction of such Work, and the Punishment for Failure to comply with such Orders", and proceeding hereupon in accordance with said previous ordinance, which is made a part hereof;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED:

Section One. That the construction of cement sidewalks be and the same is hereby ordered along or in front of the entire extent of each parcel of the property and premises hereinafter described, and that the owners of such premises proceed immediately to construct said improvements, or to cause same to be constructed at their cost and expense, on the streets and public places hereinafter named; the respective premises herein referred to, the owner or owners thereof to whom this order is addressed and each such respective street or public place being as follows, to-wit:
