

AN ORDINANCE 2011-04-14-0299

RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF A CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT APPLICATION AND AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF UP TO \$24,000.00 FOR HISTORIC FARM AND RANCH SURVEYS, RESEARCH AND STAFF TRAINING.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio (“City”) has twenty-seven (27) historic districts; six River Improvement Overlay (RIO) Districts, over 1,500 individually designated local landmarks and more than 1,800 recorded archaeological sites; and

WHEREAS, between 2003 and 2009, the San Antonio Conservation Society (SACS) and the Office of Historic Preservation surveyed and researched eighty-seven (87) 19th-century vernacular properties that qualify as Historic Texas Farm and Ranch Complexes within the city limits and Bexar County; and

WHEREAS, these extremely rare resources represent the last remaining visual vestiges of the earliest settlement of the city and surrounding areas and are highly endangered; and

WHEREAS, this grant funding will allow the Office of Historic Preservation to continue to produce National Register of Historic Places nominations for these rare resources, while also continuing the survey of 19th century farm and ranch complexes in the Heritage South area; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee, or the Historic Preservation Officer or her designee are hereby authorized to ratify and submit a Certified Local Government (CLG) grant and accept grant funds upon award in an amount up to \$12,000.00 of financial support from the Texas Historical Commission, \$10,000.00 of in-kind personnel support to be fulfilled by the Office of Historic Preservation, and \$2,000.00 cash match from the Development Services & Planning Special Revenue Fund for the period October 1, 2009 through December 31, 2011. A copy of said application is on file with the Office of Historic Preservation.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or her designee, or the Historic Preservation Officer or her designee is further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said application and acceptance.


SECTION 3. Fund 26006000 entitled "Texas Historical Commission" is hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant should funding be awarded, the sum of \$12,000.00 from the Texas Historical Commission, \$10,000.00 in-kind support, and \$2,000.00 from fund 29097000 will be appropriated in said fund. A formal final budget which will include Internal Order numbers and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the Office of Historic Preservation upon award.

SECTION 4. Upon award, the City will contribute a cash match of \$2,000.00 and an in-kind match of \$12,000.00 which is set out in the detailed budget affixed hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**. The cash match will be transferred from Fund No. 29097000, Cost Center 8029000001, GL Account No. 6102100 entitled "Interfund Transfer Out" to fund No. 26059000. Fund 26006000, GL Account No. 6101100 entitled "Interfund Transfer In".

SECTION 5. The financial fiscal allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Chief Financial Officer, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.





PURPOSE: To hire a professionally qualified historic preservation consultant to prepare National Register of Historic Places nominations for three of the 85 previously-identified 19th Century vernacular farm and ranch complexes in Bexar County. The consultant will conduct a literature review, archival research and an examination of existing survey data, maps, photographs and fieldwork in order to prepare the nominations.

5. BEGINNING & ENDING DATES: 10/1/09 - 9/30/11

6. No program income will be generated.

7. CERTIFICATION: As the duly authorized representative, I certify that this subgrant will be administered and work will be performed under the supervision of a professional meeting appropriate 36 CFR 61 requirements, in accordance with the Historic Preservation Fund Grants Manual and the Secretary of the Interior's "Standards and Guidelines for the Treatment of Historic Properties". All documentation required by the Historic Preservation Fund Grants Manual will be maintained on file for audit and State Program Review purposes. All proposed costs for personal compensation charged to the Federal or nonfederal share of this subgrant are within the maximum limit imposed by Chapter 13, Section B.34.e. of the Historic Preservation Fund Grants Manual. These costs have been assessed by knowledgeable SHPO staff and found to be within the normal and customary range of charges for similar work in the local labor market, and appear to be appropriate charges for the product to be achieved with grant assistance.
