

AN ORDINANCE 2009 - 09 - 17 - 0731J

AMENDING VARIOUS FEES CHARGED FOR PARKS AND RECREATION RELATED PROGRAMS, SERVICES, FACILITIES AND CLASSES THROUGH THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT; AND AMENDING THE CORRESPONDING SECTIONS OF THE CITY CODE TO REFLECT SUCH CHANGES.

* * * * *

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City of San Antonio to assess fees to help offset the cost of operating City facilities and services; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the City Code of the City of San Antonio to reflect these changes for the Parks and Recreation Department; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Chapter 22 PARKS AND RECREATION

SECTION 1. Section 22-7 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio, *Charges for use of baseball, softball diamonds, gymnasiums*, is hereby amended as follows:

- (1) c. is hereby amended to read as follows: "Event or tournament rental: one hundred sixty five dollars (\$165.00) for the first twelve (12) hours of use, and twenty dollars (\$20.00) per hour for each additional hour (or portion of hour) of use thereafter."
- (2) d. 1. Youth: shall be increased from one hundred sixty five dollars (\$165.00) for the first twelve (12) hours of use, and twenty dollars (\$20.00) per hour for each additional hour (or portion of hour) of use thereafter to one hundred ninety dollars (\$190.00) for the first twelve (12) hours of use, and twenty dollars (\$20.00) per hour for each additional hour (or portion of hour) of use thereafter.
 2. Adult: shall be increased from one hundred eighty dollars (\$180.00) for the first twelve (12) hours of use, and twenty dollars (\$20.00) per hour for each additional hour (or portion of hour) of use thereafter to two hundred five dollars (\$205.00) for the first twelve (12) hours of use, and twenty dollars (\$20.00) per hour for each additional hour (or portion of hour) of use thereafter.
- e. 1. is hereby amended to read as follows: "Event or tournament rental: one hundred sixty five dollars (\$165.00) for the first twelve (12) hours of use, and twenty (\$20.00) per hour for each additional hour (or portion of hour) of use thereafter."
(Delete 2.)

- (3) a. is hereby amended to read as follows: "Gym practice or game use, (no admission or entry fees may be charged), twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per hour with a two-hour minimum;
- b. fees for Special events use, shall be increased from fifty dollars (\$50.00) per hour with a two-hour minimum to seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) per hour with a two-hour minimum; if food is to be served or purveyed during the event a five hundred dollar (\$500.00) damage/clean up deposit will be paid prior to a permit being issued for this event to be returned less any costs encountered by city in repairing damage or cleaning after the event.

SECTION 2. Section 22-13 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio, *Admission fees for San Antonio Natatorium*, is hereby amended as follows:

- (b) (1) Special group rate, non-exclusive, two hour minimum, per hour... \$20.00
(2) Special group rate, exclusive use, two hour minimum, per hour... \$30.00
(3) Special group rate, exclusive use, eight hour minimum, per day...\$150.00
- (e) 1. Individuals enrolled in group swim and group water aerobics sessions offered by the city shall pay a fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) per session.
2. Individuals enrolled in private swim session shall pay a fee of \$35.00 for four (4) thirty-minute lessons.

SECTION 3. Section 22-14 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio, *Admission fees for San Antonio Botanical Center*, is hereby amended as follows:

- (a) (2) General admission, fourteen (14) through sixty-four (64) . . . \$7.00
(3) General admission, age sixty-five (65) and over...\$5.00
(4) is hereby amended to read as follows: "Group rate (fifteen (15) or more persons), ages three (3) through thirteen (13) . . . \$2.00
(5) is hereby amended to read as follows: "Group rate (fifteen (15) or more persons), age fourteen (14) and over . . . \$5.00

SECTION 4. Section 22-16 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio, *Adult athletic participation fee*, is hereby amended to add a new category in table inset:

Adult kickball	One hundred ninety-five dollars (\$195.00)

SECTION 5. Section 22-20 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio, *Fees for use of football, soccer or rugby fields*, is hereby amended as follows:

- (3) is hereby amended to read as follows: "Event or tournament rental: one hundred sixty five dollars (\$165.00) for the first twelve (12) hours of use, and twenty (\$20.00) per hour for each additional hour (or portion of hour) of use thereafter."

SECTION 6. Section 22-21.1 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio, *Participation Fees*, is hereby amended to include the following new and increased fees:

(k) is hereby amended to read as follows: "Contracted program classes, fees to be determined, and revenue divided as follows:

1. Community Centers ...seventy (70) percent to the instructor and thirty (30) percent to the city.
2. Senior Centers ... eighty (80) percent to the instructor and twenty (20) percent to the city.

Add new: (q) Swim team youth participation fee: Five dollars (\$5.00) per year, per participant.

SECTION 7. Section 22-32 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio, *Community centers, senior centers and clubhouse rental fees*, is hereby amended as follows:

- (1) Gym only practice or games use, (no admission or entry fees may be charged), twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per hour with a two-hour minimum.
- (2) Gym only or meeting room only, general use (no admission or entry fees may be charged), fifty dollars (\$50.00) per hour with a two hour minimum; if food is to be served during the use a one hundred dollar (\$100.00) damage/clean up deposit will be paid prior to a permit being issued for this use, deposit to be returned, less any expenses encountered by city for cleaning or damage.
- (3) Gym only or meeting room only, special events use, seventy five dollars (\$75.00) per hour with a two-hour minimum; if food is to be served or purveyed during the event a five hundred dollar (\$500.00) damage/cleanup deposit will be paid prior to a permit being issued for this event, deposit to be returned, less any expenses encountered by city for cleaning or damage.

SECTION 8. Section 22-136 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio, *McFarlin Tennis Center Fees*, is hereby amended as follows:


- (b) Court fees after 5:00 p.m.
- (1) Student (per person, per hour)...\$2.00
 - (2) Senior citizen (per person, per hour)...\$2.00
- (c) Tournament fees, per hour per court...\$5.00
- (d) Tournament assessment fee, per player, per event...\$2.00

SECTION 9. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 10. This ordinance shall be effective on and after October 1, 2009.


