

AN ORDINANCE 2009-05-07-0357

**AUTHORIZING CREATION OF THE SAN ANTONIO HISTORIC
PRESERVATION ACADEMY AND ESTABLISHING THE HISTORIC
PRESERVATION EDUCATION FUND.**

* * * * *

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio (“City”) has twenty-four (24) historic districts; six River Improvement Overlay (RIO) Districts, over 2,000 individually designated local landmarks and more than 2,000 recorded archaeological sites; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to enhance the City’s historic resources and further advance services to the public, the Office of Historic Preservation would like to offer workshops and training sessions to educate the public on matters relating to historic preservation; and

WHEREAS, other organizations dedicated to education and awareness of historic preservation issues may wish to collaborate with the Office of Historic Preservation in conducting such workshops or training; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The San Antonio Historic Preservation Academy, through the Office of Historic Preservation, is hereby established for the purpose of providing training and educational courses related to historic preservation.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is directed to establish a fund entitled the Historic Preservation Education Fund for collection of San Antonio Historic Preservation Academy attendance fees. The annual budget shall be revised accordingly.


- (1) San Antonio Historic Preservation Academy Fees.
 - (i) Course fees will be as established in the Office of Historic Preservation fee schedule.
 - (ii) Fees collected pursuant to the Office of Historic Preservation fee schedule shall be assessed upon registration and deposited in the Historic Preservation Education Fund created pursuant to this section.
- (2) Use of Funds. The fees shall be used to offset costs to conduct training programs sponsored by the San Antonio Historic Preservation Academy through the Office of Historic Preservation. Any remaining balance may be used only for the Office of Historic Preservation staff’s continuing education and other public training programs and is hereby appropriated for that purpose. The San Antonio Historic Preservation Academy and Historic Preservation Education Fund are to be administered by the Office of Historic Preservation.
- (3) Funds to Be Kept Separate. The balance within the Historic Preservation Education Fund shall be recorded and accounted for in a manner that distinguishes it from other general funds of the city and shall be disbursed in a manner consistent with the provisions listed above. The balance of this fund shall not be transferred to the general fund at the end of each budget year,

but rather, the balance remaining in the fund at the close of the city's fiscal year shall roll over into the balance for the next fiscal year.

SECTION 3. Should any Article, Section, Part, Paragraph, Sentence, Phrase, Clause, or Word of this Ordinance, or any appendix thereof, for any reason, be held illegal, inoperative, or invalid or if any exception to or limitation upon any general provision herein contained be held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective, the remainder shall, nevertheless, stand effective and valid as if it had been enacted and ordained without the portion held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately after passage upon the receipt of eight (8) affirmative votes, or, in the absence of eight affirmative votes, ten days after passage.


