AN ORDINANCE

REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR SAN ANTONIO RIVER IMPROVEMENTS FROM NUEVA STREET TO MARTINEZ STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. Under the rights reserved to the City all bids for furnishing material, labor, tools, apparatus, appliances and equipment necessary for the construction and completion of San Antonio River Improvements, from Nueva Street to Martinez Street, according to specifications and plans on file at the office of Hawley and Freese, Consulting Engineers, 303 Frost National Bank Building, San Antonio, Texas, be and the same are hereby rejected; and the City Clerk is directed to return the bidders checks.
