

AN ORDINANCE 2008-02-14-0117

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON THE ARTS TO FUND THE FISCAL YEAR 2009 PROJECT SUPPORT PROGRAM AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE AWARD UPON NOTIFICATION OF FUNDING.

WHEREAS, for several years, the Office of Cultural Affairs has received support from the Texas Commission on the Arts (“TCA”) for its Project Support Program and recommendations regarding the use of these state funds are usually made around the time that the Cultural Arts Board (“Board”) is making its other funding recommendations for the year; and

WHEREAS, as in the past, the state funds will be awarded to Project Support Program applicants who apply through the regular arts funding process and undergo the same review as the other applicants who will be considered for funding by the Board; and

WHEREAS, City staff is seeking authorization to submit a grant application to the TCA and to accept the award upon notification of funding; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The submission of a grant application to the Texas Commission on the Arts and the acceptance of the award upon notification of funding is authorized and approved.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or her designee, or the Director of the Office of Cultural Affairs or his designee is hereby authorized to submit a grant application, and accept grant funds upon award in an amount up to \$40,000.00 from the TCA to support the applicants of the Fiscal Year 2009 Project Support Program for the period September 1, 2008 through August 31, 2009. A copy of the application is on file with the Department of Cultural Affairs.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or her designee, or the Director of the Office of Cultural Affairs, or his designee, is further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to the application and acceptance of this grant.

SECTION 4. Fund 26005000 entitled “National Endowment For The Arts” is designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant and, should funding be awarded, the sum of up to \$40,000.00 from the TCA will be appropriated in said fund. A formal budget, which will include Internal Order numbers and General Ledger numbers, will be submitted by the Office of Cultural Affairs upon award.




by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth day after passage.


