AN ORDINANCE **65589**

ORDERING A BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 3RD DAY OF NOVEMBER 1987 IN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS ON A PROPOSED BOND ISSUE FOR STREET AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS; MAKING PROVISION FOR THE HOLDING OF SAID ELECTION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

* * * * *

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas (the "City") hereby finds that an election should be held to determine whether said governing body shall be authorized to issue bonds of said City in the amounts and for the purposes hereinafter identified; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. A bond election shall be held on Tuesday, the 3rd day of November, 1987, in accordance with the laws of Texas and the provisions of the Charter of the City of San Antonio, and the official ballots for said election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code and at said election the following PROPOSITIONS shall be submitted in accordance with law:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

"Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas be authorized to issue and sell general obligations bonds of the City in the principal amount of \$56,200,000.00 for the purpose of making permanent public improvements and for public purposes, to wit, constructing street improvements and drainage incidental thereto, with respect to:

and after making due provision therefore the City Council, in its discretion, may use any excess funds for constructing other street improvements and drainage incidental thereto; such bonds to mature serially or otherwise not more than forty (40) years from their issued date; and any issue or series of said bonds to bear interest at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable or otherwise) as may be determined within the discretion of said City Council, provided that such rate of interest shall not exceed the maximum rate per annum authorized by law at the time of the issuance of any issue or series of said bonds; and shall the City Council be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the annual interest and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity?"

PROPOSITION NO. 2

"Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas be authorized to issue and sell general obligations bonds of the City in the principal amount of \$83,800,000.00 for the purpose of making permanent public improvements and for public purposes, to wit, constructing facilities for the detection and removal of, and protection from harmful excesses of water in the acquisition of lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto, with respect to:

and after making due provision therefore the City Council, in its discretion, may use any excess funds for constructing facilities for the removal of harmful excesses of water and the acquisition of lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto: such bonds to mature serially or otherwise not more than forty (40) years from their issue date; and any issue or series of said bonds to bear interest at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable or otherwise) as may be determined within the discretion of said City Council, provided that such rate of interest shall not exceed the maximum rate per annum authorized by law at the time of the issuance of any issue or series of said bonds; and shall the City Council be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the annual interest and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity?"

SECTION 2. The official ballots for said election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code so as to

permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid PROPOSITIONS, with the ballots to contain such provisions, markings, and language as required by law, and with such PROPOSITIONS to be expressed substantially as follows:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

FOR X "THE ISSUANCE OF \$56,200,000.00 OF GENERAL
OBLIGATION BONDS FOR CONSTRUCTING STREET
IMPROVEMENTS AND DRAINAGE INCIDENTAL THERETO"
AGAINST X

PROPOSITION NO. 2

FOR X "THE ISSUANCE OF \$83,800,000.00 OF GENERAL
OBLIGATION BONDS FOR CONSTRUCTING FACILITIES FOR
THE DETECTION AND REMOVAL OF AND PROTECTION FROM
HARMFUL EXCESSES OF WATER AND THE ACQUISITION OF
LANDS AND RIGHTS-OF-WAY NECESSARY THERETO"
AGAINST X

SECTION 3. Said election shall be held as prescribed by law, in the City of San Antonio at the following polling or voting places in the several precincts of the City of San Antonio listed in Attachment "I" between the hours of 7:00 o'clock A.M. and 7:00 o'clock P.M.

SECTION 4. Voting at said election shall be done by the use of voting machines, paper ballots or the electronic voting system as determined by the City Clerk, and the City Council of the City of San Antonio does determine hereby that voting machines, paper ballots or electronic voting system shall be used for the casting of absentee votes at this election, and voting machines shall be placed in the City Hall of San Antonio, Texas and at temporary branch offices (Attachment II) established for the purpose of conducting absentee voting by personal appearance, during the hours that the City Clerk's main business office is regularly open for business.

SECTION 5. Notice of said bond election shall be given by posting a substantial copy of this Ordinance at three (3) public places in the City of San Antonio and also at the City Hall, not less than 15 days prior to the date set for said election; and a substantial copy of this Ordinance also shall be published on the same day in each of two successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of San Antonio, the date of the first publication to be not less than 14 nor more than 30 days prior to the date set for said election.

SECTION 6. All bonds voted at said election shall be issued only in accordance with, and subject to all restrictions and

requirements of, all applicable laws.

SECTION 7. All resident qualified electors of the City of San Antonio shall be entitled to vote at said election.

SECTION 8. Effective Date. The effective date of this ordinance shall be governed by the provisions of Section 9 hereof if this ordinance is adopted by the affirmative vote of at least eight (8) members of the City Council, otherwise, the same shall take effective on the 11th day after the date of its adoption by the City Council.

SECTION 9. Emergency. By reason of the urgent necessity to issue bonds as soon as possible to enable the City to proceed with needed public improvements, an emergency is hereby declared to exist making it necessary to the preservation of the public peace, property, health and safety that this ordinance become effective immediately upon its passage, and is so enacted.
