AN ORDINANCE

CALLING AN ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF
METHOD OF OPERATION OF THE CITY WATER
SYSTEM.

* * *

WHEREAS, on June 12, 1956, an election will be held in the City of San Antonio, Texas, on the question of the issuance of \$20,885,000.00 Waterworks Improvement and Extension Revenue Bonds; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to know the wishes of the citizens as to the method of operation of the City Water System should the refunding of presently outstanding revenue bonds be accomplished; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That an election be held in the City of San Antonio, Texas, on June 12, 1956, at which election there shall be submitted the question of the manner of operation of the City Water System.

2. The ballots for said election shall have written or printed thereon the following:

"IF THE NEW REVENUE BONDS ARE APPROVED AND ISSUED,
HOW SHALL THE WATER SYSTEM BE OPERATED?"

(Vote for one of the following.)

- a. By an independent board of trustees nominated and appointed by the City Council for staggered terms.
- b. As an ^{or division} administrative department of the City under the City Council and City Manager."

3. Said election shall be held at the places designated in the ordinance passed and approved on May 17, 1956, entitled "Ordinance by the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, calling an election on the question of the issuance of \$20,885,000.00 Waterworks Improvement and Extension Revenue Bonds," and the persons named in said ordinance shall serve as officers of the election called hereby. Paragraph 2 of said ordinance, listing the polling places and election officers is hereby incorporated herein by reference as fully as if it were copied and included herein.

4. The ballot described in Paragraph 2 hereof shall be placed on the same voting machines as are used for the bond election to be held on June 12, 1956.

5. A substantial copy of this ordinance signed by the Mayor of said City and attested by the City Clerk shall serve as proper notice of said election. Notice shall be given in accordance with Article 704, Revised Civil Statutes of 1925, as amended. The Mayor is authorized and directed to have a copy of said notice posted at the City Hall in said City, and at each of the voting places in said City, not less than fifteen days prior to the date fixed for holding said election. He shall also cause said notice to be published on the same day in each of two successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published within said City, the date of the first publication to be not less than fourteen

days prior to the date set for said election. Except as otherwise provided in said Article 704, as amended, the manner of holding said election shall be governed by the laws governing general elections.


