On motion, of Commissioner Steffler, duly seconded and carried, the following agreement between the City of San Antonio and the State Highway Department was adopted.

## AGREEMENT

BY MUNICIPALITY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION TO MAINTAIN HIGHWAYS IMPROVED UNDER NATIONAL INDUSTRIAL ACT.

The City of San Antonio \_\_\_\_\_, State of Texas, herein referred to as CITY, and  
(Municipality or political subdivision)  
the State Highway Department \_\_\_\_\_, hereinafter referred to as the Highway Department hereby

agree as follows:

1. That the Highway Department will submit a project for the improvement of 1.061 miles of MUNICIPAL highway from South City Limits of San Antonio to Ripford  
(Municipal, secondary or feeder)  
Street, known as Nogalitos Street, and to be designated as U. S. Public Works  
(Local Name of Street or Road) State  
project No. NRM 264-B and will recommend its approval by the Secretary of Agriculture for construction with funds apportioned to the State under Section 204 of the National Industrial Act subject, however, to the condition that the CITY OF SAN ANTONIO shall provide for its proper maintenance after completion of its improvement.

2. That the said CITY OF SAN ANTONIO hereby request the Highway Department to submit the aftermentioned project with recommendation that it be approved by the Secretary of Agriculture, and agrees that if such project is approved and constructed by the Highway Department and the Secretary of Agriculture it thereafter, at its own cost and expense will maintain the project in a manner satisfactory to them, or their authorized representative and will make ample provisions each year for such maintenance.

TEXAS STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT.

Commissioner Steffler, introduced the following resolution, which was on his motion adopted by unanimous vote of the Commissioners.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the State Highway Department of the State of Texas is desirous of designating State Highway No. 2, through the City of San Antonio, from the south City Limits to the North City Limits of San Antonio, and routing traffic over Nogalitos Street, South Alamo, Alamo North Alamo, Fourth Street and Broadway, and,

WHEREAS, the participation of the State Highway Department of Texas in the designation of said highway is contingent upon the City of San Antonio agreeing to refrain from permitting encroachments upon the right-of-way of said above mentioned street, and until and unless the City of San Antonio agrees to refrain from passing ordinances or laws fixing a speed limit of less than twenty miles per hour on said above mentioned street, and until and unless the City of San Antonio agrees to refrain from erecting signs, semaphores, and signals that will give preference to local routes or that will hinder or delay traffic on said above mentioned street.

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of San Antonio, that for and in consideration of the State Highway Department of the State of Texas designating said Highway No. 2, through the City of San Antonio from the South City Limits at Nogalitos Street, and routing traffic over Nogalitos Street, South Alamo Street, Alamo, North Alamo, Fourth Street and Broadway to the North City Limits, is hereby agrees with the State Highway Department of the State of Texas, and it will not, in the future, permit encroachment of the right-of-way of said above mentioned street, nor will it pass an ordinance or laws fixing a speed limit on the above mentioned street of under twenty miles per hour, nor will it allow the erection of signs, semaphores and signals that will give preference to local routes which intersect with said mentioned street, nor that will slow up, hinder or delay traffic on said above mentioned street, nor will it repeal or amend any of the provisions of this Resolution without consent of the State Highway Department.

This is to certify that the above Resolution was adopted and passed at a meeting of the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, on May, 18th, 1934.
