

AN ORDINANCE **63071**

AMENDING CERTAIN LANGUAGE IN PUBLIC STREETLIGHTING ELECTRIC RATE SCHEDULES OF THE CITY PUBLIC SERVICE BOARD OF SAN ANTONIO TO INCORPORATE REVISED PUBLIC STREETLIGHTING RATES.

WHEREAS, on November 7, 1985, the City Council of the City of San Antonio passed and approved Ordinance No. 61794 regulating the rates for electric and gas service through the San Antonio Electric and Gas Systems operated by the City Public Service Board of San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, unexpected substantial savings were realized through bulk rate, direct purchases of Decorative Streetlights for which there was no cost experience; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the rate schedules for the Streetlighting Service Public Streetlighting Rate (SSP) contained in Section 1 of Ordinance No. 61794 in order to provide for revisions to the Public Streetlighting Rate; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. That portion of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 61794, containing the rate schedules for Streetlighting Service Public Streetlighting Electric Rate (SSP) under the paragraph labeled "MONTHLY BILL", shall be amended to include the following under the underground distribution:

25,000	250	High Pressure Sodium Single Mast Arm - Decorative	\$19.95
25,000	250	High Pressure Sodium Double Mast Arm - Decorative	\$31.85

SECTION 2. By reason of the urgent requirements to continue dependable service to the customers of the electric system, an emergency is hereby declared to exist making it necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health and safety that this Ordinance become effective immediately upon its enactment and it is so enacted.

Message:

Summary:

City Public Service requests a reduction in the special Decorative Streetlight available to developers and others. The reason is that CPS has been able to make bulk and direct purchases of materials for these installations at substantial savings from original forecasts, which are factored into the present rates. These savings are to be passed on to customers through reduced rates in order to reflect proper cost of service.

Background:

The present Decorative Streetlight rates included in the present SSP Rate Schedule effective 1/2/86 was rederived using lower (actual) CPS installed cost experience. The rederived rates proposed for adoption in the new Ordinance are:

Decorative - Single Fixture Mastarm	\$19.95/month
Decorative - Double Fixture Mastarm	\$31.85/month

These costs and related rates are lower than was originally derived, since the rate is for a new type of installation and no actual cost experience was available at first.

Financial:

The revenue change to CPS due to this reduction in rates is expected to be very small. The Decorative rate was instituted as an option for developers, and is not in general use.

Conclusion:

City Public Service requests the approval of the enclosed rate ordinance to better reflect the Decorative Streetlight rate cost-of-service.
