Seven proposals to furnish the City with Binders or Ledger Sheets were opened and read and referred to the City Purchasing Agent for tabulation and report.



Commissioner Anderson recommended that the following petitions be granted: Adopted.


^{MS-1123} Petition of San Antonio Public Service Company for permit to install two 1000 gal. steel storage reservoirs in City Block 1906.
