

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

THURSDAY, JUNE 4th, 1925, 10: 0'CLOCK A. M.

PRESENT: Honorable John W. Tobin, Mayor, presiding and Commissioners Steffler, and Wright.
Absent, Bushick, and Lambert.

His Honor the Mayor announced that the meeting had been called for the purpose of passing An Ordinance, authorizing transfer of \$21,000.00 from the Back Tax Fund to the 1922 General Fund, whereupon Commissioner Steffler read the following ordinances, which were read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit; Ayes, Tobin, Steffler, Wright.

No. 21 *MF-1621* AN ORDINANCE

Transferring \$21,000.00 from Back Tax General Fund to 1922 General Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the Commissioner of Taxation, as ex-officio City Treasurer, and the City Auditor, be and they are hereby ordered and directed to transfer or cause to be transferred, the sum of Twenty One Thousand Dollars (\$21,000.00), from the Back Tax General Fund to the 1922 General Fund.

No. 22 *MF-1622* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$19,665.98 out of Flood Prevention Fund of 1924, payable to Colglazier & Hoff, being Estimate No. 4 for construction work at Olmos Dam

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Nineteen Thousand, Six Hundred Sixty Five Dollars and ninety eight cents (\$19,665.98), be and the same is hereby appropriated out of Flood Prevention Fund of 1924, payable to Colglazier and Hoff, being Estimate No. 4, for construction work at Olmos Dam.
