

REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

FRIDAY, DECEMBER 23rd, A. D. 1927, 10:00 A. M.

PURSUANT: to the order of adjournment of the Meeting of December 19, 1927.

PRESENT: Honorable C. M. Chambers, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Bushick, Steffler, Wright. When the following proceedings were had.

The following petition was ordered entered upon the minutes for the purpose of a permanent record, with all endorsements thereon; to-wit:

Petition

Travis Investment Co., for the exchange of properties for the re-location of East Salinas Street.

To the Honorable Mayor and Commissioners,
City of San Antonio, Texas.

Sept. 11, 1926.

Gentlemen:-

The Travis Investment Company respectfully request your consent to changing the alley in the block bounded by Travis, Soledad, Armistead Streets and the San Antonio River. All of this block is owned by W. L. Holder and the Travis Investment Company. The alley at present ends at the River and its principal use to the abutting properties is for light and ventilation. Being a blind alley it cannot serve the general public in any way.

The Travis Investment Company will lose some frontage on Soledad Street and Mr. Holder will gain some frontage on Soledad Street. Mr. Holder will lose some space at the rear of his property and the Travis Investment Company will gain some space at the rear of their property.

The Travis Investment Company, in consideration of the City's making this change in the alley will deed to the City a strip of ground along the entire Travis Street side of this property of sufficient width to make the Travis Street sidewalk 15 feet wide. The present sidewalk, we understand from the City Engineer's office is 8 feet 2½ inches wide. We will therefore, deed a strip 6 feet 9½ inches wide on Soledad by 193 feet on Travis for public purposes.

Mr. W. L. Holder joins us in the petition that this request be granted.

The consummation of this exchange will require a deed from W. L. Holden to the City of San Antonio of the property designated Triangle "B" on blue print enclosed; a deed from the City of San Antonio to W. L. Holden of Triangle "A"; a deed from the Travis Investment Company to the City of San Antonio, conveying Triangle "C" and Strip "D"; a deed from the City of San Antonio to the Travis Investment Company of Triangle "E".
