Westfall, deceased, in Elmendorf, Texas, for a period of twenty-five (25) years in consideration of the Executrix of the said deceased duly transferring and conveying to the City of San Antonio all of the property so devised to said San Antonio Public Library under the will of the said deceased;

Petition of Humble Oil & Refining Company for permit to replace 2 old style electric pumps with 2 new model electric pumps at 223 N. Zarzamora Street, was read and referred to Police & Fire Commissioner.

Mr. Dan Genard addressed the Commissioners with reference to widening West Commerce Street adjacent to Milan Square and City Market House. The Mayor announced that the Commissioners would take the proposition under consideration.
