

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

THURSDAY, DECEMBER 4TH, A.D.1919, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Coy, Lambert, Heuermann, Wright.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police: Oriental Oil Co. for permit to erect drive-in station, Alamo and Goliad Streets.

For arc lamp Grant Avenue & Russell Place.

Grover C. Cain, for permit to install gasoline filling station, Van Ness and Hackberry Sts.

Petition for paving Kayton Avenue, and petition of Emma G. Davis regarding sewer right of way across lots in C.B.1751 were read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements.

All bids for constructing sanitary sewers in Government Hill District (Contract Section 54) were opened and referred to City Engineer for tabulation.

Commissioner Heuermann introduced the following resolution, which was read and adopted:

RESOLUTION.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, bids for constructing sidewalks and curbing, submitted by W.W. Lehr and W.T. Southwell to be laid on Peck Avenue, are hereby rejected.

Commissioner Heuermann recommended that petition of J.D. Oppenheimer for permit to construct a spur track across Arsenal Street to serve Goodyear Rubber Co. be granted, and that the City Attorney be requested to draw up necessary franchise ordinance. Adopted.

AN ORDINANCE *MD-207*

Appropriating \$328.50, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the sidewalk and Curbing Fund to pay Wm Reilly for constructing curbing along Burleson Street, as per estimate of the City Engineer to be filed in the office of the City Auditor.

AN ORDINANCE *-208*

Appropriating \$1192.59 to pay Wm Reilly for building curbing and sidewalks.
BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that the sum of \$1192.59, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to pay Wm Reilly for building curbing and sidewalks along different streets, as per estimate of the City Engineer to be filed in the office of the City Auditor.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Sixty (\$60.00) Dollars be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to pay J.W. Cozad the rental due in advance for one year beginning December 1, 1919 on one half of Lot 26, C.B. 3073, on which is located the East End Animal pound.

AN ORDINANCE *-213*

Appropriating the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) to pay Mr. Pat Donoghue for services rendered the City of San Antonio.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General

Fund, charged to the Incinerator Bond Issue Fund, to pay Mr Pat Donoghue for services rendered in taking laborers and carpenters building houses for help at plant to and from the Incinerator Plant for ten weeks, before and after working hours.

Commissioner Lambert submitted the report of Milk Inspection for the month of November, which was ordered filed.

On motion, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
