BE IT REMEMBERED THAT THE HONORABLE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT in and for said County, met at the Court-house thereof, in the City of San Antonio, on Thursday, October 28th, 1915, at four o'clock P.M. in joint session with the Honorable City Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas:

When the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

In the matter of the selection of material to be used in the construction of the Robert B. Green Memorial Hospital;

The representatives of the Calavaras Brick Company, Elgin Standard Brick Company, Acme Brick Company, Elgin Brick and Tile Company, San Antonio, Sand Lime Brick Company, Seguin Brick and Tile Company and Atlantic Terra Cotta Company, appeared before the Honorable Body with samples of material and were each given ten minutes time within which to explain the merits of the different materials, and to quote prices on same.

Upon motion of the Honorable City Commissioner, Albert Steves, Sr., seconded by the Honorable City Commissioner J.R. Lambert, all members present voting "aye",

It was ordered by the Court that the Blue Mottel Selected Face Brick at \$11.00 per thousand delivered at the building site, and manufactured by the San Antonio Lime Brick Company be used in the construction of the Robert B. Green Memorial Hospital.

Upon motion of the Honorable Clinton G. Brown, Mayor of the City of San Antonio, seconded by the Honorable City Commissioner, James F. Garland, all members present voting "Aye" except the Honorable City Commissioners Albert Steves, Sr., and J. R. Lambert, voting "Nay" it was ordered by the Court that the H. N. Jones Construction Company, Contractors for the construction of the Robert B. Green Memorial Hospital be allowed an additional amount of \$3,500.00 for substituting Atlantic Terra Cotta in place of Cast Stone on the entrance, sills, coping and cornice of the Robert B. Green Memorial

Hospital.

The joint session then upon motion made and carried, adjourned.
