AN ORDINANCE *MD-78*

Appropriating \$2,386.56 to pay McGill Construction Co. for repair work on  
Houston Street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio that the sum of  
Two Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty Eight and 56/100 (\$2388.56) be and the same is  
hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to pay McGill Construction Co. for  
repairing wood block paving on Houston Street, from Alamo Street to N. Flores Street,  
as per final estimate of City Engineer on file in the office of the City Auditor.

AN ORDINANCE *-81*

Appropriating money to defray expenses for band concert held at Bracken-  
ridge Park on Sunday Srptember 21, 1919 by Smiths band.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of  
One Hundred Twelve and 50/100 (\$112.50) dollars be and is hereby appropriated out of  
the Zoo Fund to defray the espense of band concert given in Brackenridge Park on  
Sunday.

Commissioner Heuermann submitted a communication from the City Purchasing Agent recommending that the bid of the Citizens Auto Company to furnish one 5½ ton Model E. Packard Truck, and the bid of the Wheeler & Lacey Co. to furnish two 5 ton White Trucks to the City for \$6000.00 each be accepted. Adopted.


