

AN ORDINANCE **89544**

AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS IN CONNECTION WITH THE 1999 FIESTA SAN ANTONIO CELEBRATION; APPROVING THE LOCATIONS, DATES AND TIMES FOR THE FIESTA CARNIVAL, AND RELATED REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS; APPROVING THE FIESTA PARADE ROUTES; AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO.87566, PASSED ON MARCH 26, 1998 TO REFLECT SUCH CHANGES.

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WHEREAS, San Antonio's annual Fiesta San Antonio Celebration, through the dedicated efforts of many civic-minded persons and nonprofit organizations, has achieved state wide, national, and international recognition as one of the outstanding festival events in our nation; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No.88270 of August 13,1998, set the dates for Fiesta San Antonio for the years 1999 through 2008, designated the Fiesta San Antonio Commission as the planning and coordinating organization for the event, provided for and allocated financial support to Fiesta events, adopted regulations for Fiesta events, and made other provisions in connection with Fiesta; and

WHEREAS, planning is underway for the 1999 Fiesta San Antonio and it is necessary to approve certain events, close streets to vehicular traffic in connection with certain events, approve dates, times and locations for events, and set certain rules, regulations and conditions for staging these events; and

WHEREAS, in planning for the 1999 Fiesta San Antonio, it has been agreed that certain portions of Ordinance No.87566, of March 26,1998, be amended; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The following Fiesta events are approved for the dates, times and on the conditions set forth below. The listed public streets and ways shall be closed to vehicular traffic during the dates and times indicated to facilitate the events and their use of the public property.

1. **SOUTHWEST CRAFT CENTER ART FAIR**: Augusta Street from Giraud Street to Navarro Street will be made a temporary one way (eastbound). The street will be closed from 12:00 noon on Friday, April 16,1999 to 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, April 18,1999 to accommodate unloading and set-up of Fair exhibits and parking of service vehicles. Two (2) off-duty police officers will be required to direct traffic on site on Friday, April 16,1999 from 12:00 noon to 6:00 p.m.; Saturday, April 17,1999 from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.; Sunday, April 18,1999 from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
2. **NIGHT IN OLD SAN ANTONIO**: South Presa Street from Market Street to Nueva Street, the median and west bound lanes of Nueva Street from South Alamo Street to 100 feet west of South Presa Street; the eastbound turning lane of Nueva Street approximately 100 feet west of Alamo Street; southbound curb lane of Alamo Street between Villita and Nueva Streets are streets that will be closed from Saturday, April 17,1999 at 8:30 a.m. until Sunday, April 25,1999 at 12:00 p.m.
3. **FIESTA DEL MERCADO**: San Saba Street from Dolorosa to West Commerce Street. *During Pre-Fiesta week*: the east lane will be closed for booth set-up work on Monday, April 12,1999 beginning at 12:00 noon to Friday, April 16,1999 at 10:00 a.m.; the west side sidewalk will also be closed for booth set-up; one traffic lane will be open down the middle of the street; pedestrian access will be maintained on the street in front of the closed sidewalk; the east side sidewalk will remain open. *During Fiesta week*: the street will be closed on Friday, April 16,1999 at 10:00 a.m. and left closed continuously through Monday,

April 26, 1999. At 8:00 a.m. on Monday, April 26, 1999, the center traffic lane will open but the east side lane of San Saba Street and the west side sidewalk will remain closed for booth tear down until 12:00 midnight. In addition, the drive/walk on the west side of Farmers Market (under IH 35) will be used for band parking during Fiesta Week. Fiestas Market Square, Inc. shall be responsible, at their expense, for barricades. **THE ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ON SIDWALKS AND CROSSWALKS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**

4. **ST. MARY'S OYSTER BAKE:** Marquette Street from 36th Street to Camino Santa Maria; Overhill Street from 36th Street to Camino Santa Maria; Ligustrum Street from Woodlawn to Marquette Street; Riverdale from 36th Street to Hillcrest are streets that will be closed to thru traffic on Friday, April 16, 1999 from 5:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. and Saturday, April 17, 1999 from 10:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. Camino Santa Maria from Colgate to Wake Forest (westside curb only for VIA bus parking, twelve foot (12') width, from face of curb) on Friday, April 16, 1999 at 2:00 p.m. and remaining closed until 10:00 p.m., Saturday, April 17, 1999.

5. **FIESTA MISSION RUN:** East White Avenue from Mission Parkway to Padre Drive; Mission Parkway from East White to Mission Road; Mission Road from Mission Parkway to Mission Concepcion; Padre Drive from East White to Pyron Avenue; Pyron Avenue from Padre Drive to San Jose Drive are streets which will be closed on Saturday, April 17, 1999 from 8:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m.

6. **PILGRIMAGE TO THE ALAMO:** Auditorium Circle and Alamo Plaza from East Houston Street to Crockett Street. Parkway will be restricted or prohibited on Martin Street from Jefferson Street to Navarro Street and Jefferson Street to Commerce Street. The streets will be closed on Monday, April 19, 1999 from 3:00 p.m. until 5:30 p.m.

7. **RIVER PARADE STREET PARTY:** Convent Street from Soledad Street to Augusta Street on Monday, April 19, 1999 from 12:00 noon until 12:00 midnight.

8. **PARADES: BATTLE OF FLOWERS AND FIESTA FLAMBEAU:** Both parades shall assemble at E. Grayson and Broadway and proceed south on Broadway, east on 3rd Street, south on Alamo Street, west on Commerce, then north on Santa Rosa to Martin where the parade will disband. Broadway from Newell to Jones Avenue shall be closed on Saturday, April 24, 1999 from 11:00 p.m. until Sunday, April 25, 1999 at 2:00 a.m. for bleacher removal.

9. **KING WILLIAM FAIR:** East Guenther from South Alamo Street to River Authority Parking Lot; King William Street from East Guenther to South St. Mary's Street; East Johnson and East Sheridan Streets from the San Antonio River to S. Alamo Street; East Sheridan from the San Antonio River to South Alamo Street; Beauregard and Turner Streets from Washington to South Alamo Street; Pancoast at Durango Street; Arsenal Street to City Street; Madison from East Guenther to St. Mary's Street; and Washington from Arsenal to Turner are streets which will be closed on Friday, April 23, 1999 from 7:30 a.m. until Saturday, April 24, 1999, 9:00 p.m. In addition, Eagleland Street from St. Mary's Street to Guenther Street will be closed on Saturday, April 25 from 7:30 a.m. until 12:00 noon for parade staging.

10. **ST LUKE'S FIESTA FINALE:** Manitou Drive from Callaghan to Winlock from 11:00 am. Until 11:00 p.m. on Sunday, April 25, 1999. Winlock Drive from Horizon to Callaghan will be made temporarily one-way with traffic flowing north to south.

11. **FIESTA EN LA VILLA DE SAN FERNANDO:** East lane of Main Street closed at 12:00 midnight on Wednesday, April 21, 1999 for set-up of booths. Main Street closed from Dolorosa to Commerce on Thursday, April 22, 1999 from 12:00 noon until 12:00 midnight; Friday, April 23, from 12:00 noon until 12:00 midnight; Saturday, April 24, 1999 from 12:00 noon until 12:00 midnight; Sunday, April 25, 1999 from 12:00 noon until 10:00 p.m.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No.87566 passed and approved on March 26,1998 is hereby amended so that the list of dates selected for the 1998 Fiesta San Antonio events and activities in Section 1 of said Ordinance is changed to the 1999 dates stated in Section 1 herein. Said Ordinance is further amended so that the carnival site, as provided for in Section 3, is changed. The Ordinance is hereby amended to adopt a carnival location map for the 1999 carnival. A copy of the approved location is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Attachment I.

SECTION 3. The 1999 Carnival shall conform its operations to the following schedule, requirements and conditions. The Fiesta Commission shall enforce these regulations through its contract for the carnival concession.

A. **CARNIVAL SCHEDULE:** The hours of operation shall be as follows:

- C. The plan for placement of carnival booths, stands, and carnival rides must be received by the City Manager's Office on or before Monday, April 5, 1999. The plan must be approved by the Police Department. The plan must provide for Police Command Posts at the carnival location as requested by the Police Department and include utility services as necessary.
- D. The Carnival Concessionaire shall provide sight triangles at street intersections, which are not closed to traffic, in accordance with the standards set out in the City's Codes and Ordinances.
- E. The Carnival Concessionaire shall erect, at its expense, a five foot (5') chain link fence at the following locations, if applicable:
 - 1. In all medians on Santa Rosa from Nueva Street to Houston Street
 - 2. San Pedro Creek between Dolorosa and Commerce Streets
 - 3. Around all plant materials at City Hall as approved by the Parks and Recreation Department
 - 4. Around the Plaza de Armas and Spanish Governor's Palace: plant materials, flagstone sidewalk and statue
 - 5. On the south side of West Commerce from South Flores to Cameron, behind the sidewalk
 - 6. On South Flores between West Commerce and Dolorosa
- F. The Carnival Concessionaire shall provide an alternate off-street loading area for Fawcett Furniture Company. If required by merchants, Carnival Concessionaires shall erect, at its expense, fencing along Dolorosa Street to accommodate merchants.
- G. The Carnival Concessionaire shall, at its expense, maintain chemical toilets with large banners above the area and security lighting. The location and number of toilets shall be as required by the Director of Health. All chemical toilets shall be serviced a minimum of every four hours during the hours that the carnival is open to the public and once after the carnival closes. If a chemical toilet overflows, the area shall be cleaned immediately.
- H. The Carnival Concessionaire shall, at its expense, provide garbage receptacles and/or dumpsters on the Carpool Lot. The City of San Antonio, if necessary, shall determine additional locations.
- I. The Carnival Concessionaire shall coordinate with the respective utility companies to insure that all manhole covers are covered and secured.
- J. Cones and barrels at distances specified by the Public Works Department shall be erected on carnival areas located on City streets in order to delineate closed lanes by the Carnival Concessionaire.
- K. The Carnival Concessionaire, at its expense, shall execute and deliver to the City Clerk's Office by Monday, April 5, 1999 a Performance Bond in the amount of \$50,000.00 approved by the City as to form and sufficiency, guaranteeing that the Carnival Concessionaire shall comply with all terms, conditions and provision of this ordinance and all other applicable City Ordinances. The Performance Bond shall be valid through June 25, 1999.
- L. The Carnival Concessionaire shall provide and pay for supplementary twenty-four (24) hour security (City of San Antonio Police Officers) for City Hall, Plaza de Armas, and the City Hall Annex at 506 Dolorosa Street from Friday April 16, 1999 through Monday, April 26, 1999. The Carnival Concessionaire shall also provide and pay for security for the south parking area of the Health Department from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., April 12, 1999 through April 16, 1999 and from

April 19, 1999 through April 23, 1999. The officers shall be paid at the rate of time consistent with the Police and Fire Collective Bargaining Agreement. All such City documented security costs shall be paid in full to the City of San Antonio no later than seven (7) days after receipt of the final invoices from the Police Department.

- M. The Carnival Concession shall provide and pay for one (1) on call fire inspector for the carnival site from 4:30 p.m. to carnival closing, each day from April 14, 1999 to April 25, 1999. The fire inspector shall be paid at the rate of time consistent with the Police and Fire Collective Bargaining Agreement. All such City documented inspection costs shall be paid in full to the City of San Antonio no later than seven (7) days after receipt of the final invoices from the Fire Department.
- N. The Carnival Concessionaire shall comply with all other conditions set by the City Managers Office necessary to insure the public health, safety and welfare.
- O. All sidewalks located next to or in the carnival area must remain open to full width during non-carnival operating hours. No encroaching of any sort will be allowed during noncarnival operating hours.
- P. A fifteen foot (15') firelane must remain open with no obstructions of any sort on Dolorosa from Santa Rosa to South Flores streets, and Laredo from Nueva to Commerce Streets during carnival operating hours.
- Q. At any time, the City's rights-of-ways are closed or partially closed, the Carnival Concessionaire is obligated to adhere to the City's latest barricade standards and specifications.
- R. The Carnival Concessionaire shall provide substitute parking for the Health Department Parking Lot and the Dolorosa Parking Lot during the Carnival setup, event, and teardown, and incur the cost for replacement parking.
- S. The Carnival Concessionaire shall reimburse the City for lost revenues for use of the Health Department, Dolorosa, and Cattleman Square parking Lots. In addition to the revenue reimbursement for the Cattleman Square parking lot, the Carnival Concessionaire agrees to reimburse the City \$3,000 for fencing and contractual services required to return this lot to service. The Carnival Concessionaire shall promptly repair at its own cost, any damage to parking lot infrastructure, including irrigation lines, when notified by the City and as included in the current Fiesta Carnival Contract.
- T. The Carnival Concessionaire shall provide, at its expense, a certified barricade contractor on the first Wednesday and Thursday of carnival operation. The barricade contractor must provide a truck driver, and at least 300-night time cones to be utilized as directed by the Police Department Traffic Section. A Police Officer will accompany this driver. The hours this driver, truck and material will be needed shall begin one (1) hour before, one (1) hour after, and during carnival operating hours.

SECTION 4. The Battle of Flowers, and the Fiesta Flambeau, scheduled for Friday, April 23, 1999 and Saturday, April 24, 1999 respectively, are hereby approved. A copy of the parade route is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment II. The public streets and ways indicated on Attachment II, as the 1999 Fiesta Parade Route, shall be closed to vehicular traffic during the aforementioned dates, at times specified by the Chief of Police, to facilitate the event's use of public property.

SECTION 5. Bleacher placement along the parade route is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment III and is hereby approved.

The permission granted by the U.S. Postal Service, as set out in Attachment IV attached hereto and incorporated herein, permitting placement of bleachers along the west side of the Federal Building on Alamo Plaza without blocking the letter collection boxes and the entrance to the ramp on the west side of the Federal Building is hereby acknowledged and approved.

SECTION 7. Except as amended herein, the 1999 Fiesta San Antonio celebration shall be conducted in accordance with Ordinance No.88270, passed and approved on August 13, 1998.


SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the passage hereof.

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION

This ordinance authorizes the closure of certain streets in connection with Fiesta 1999, approves the dates and times for specified Fiesta events, approves the location, dates and times for the Fiesta Carnival and related requirements and conditions, and approves the Fiesta Parade routes.

Staff concurs with the City Council Fiesta Committee recommendation to approve this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

1. **SOUTHWEST CRAFT CENTER ART FAIR:** Augusta Street from Giraud Street to Navarro Street will be made a temporary one way (eastbound). POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance will allow for the timely planning, coordination and development of the Fiesta San Antonio events for 1999 in accordance with the adopted agreement between the City of San Antonio and the Fiesta Commission.

COORDINATION

These events have been coordinated with the City Manager's Office, the City Council Fiesta Committee, the Police Department, the Fire Department, the Public Works Department, the Parks & Recreation Department, the Building Inspections Department, the Metropolitan Health District, the Office of Budget and Management Analysis, the City Attorney's Office and the Fiesta Commission. All of the involved organizations concur with the staff recommendation to approve this request.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The annual City expenditures for Fiesta San Antonio are approximately \$900,000.00. The City provides police officers for traffic control and security at some Fiesta events. The City also provides inspectors, but concessionaires are required to pay the inspection fees as set in the annual budget. Revenues are received from Fiesta sponsors by separate contractual arrangements for rental of city facilities. New for this Fiesta is the addition of the Cattleman Square Parking Lot as an additional site for carnival rides. The Carnival Concessionaire has agreed to reimburse the City \$23,000 for lost parking revenues and \$3,000 for additional fencing and site restoration services. This amount is in addition to the lost revenue reimbursement the Carnival Concesionaire will remit for the use of the Dolorosa and Health Department parking lots.
