1. That it is the intention of the City Council not to hereafter appoint, or approve the appointment of any person to any City board, commission, committee or authority unless such person resides within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio.
2. That this Resolution shall not effect the status of present members of any such boards or commissions but apply only to appointees from and after the passage hereof.

After the regular order of business had been disposed of, the Mayor called upon anyone else wishing to be heard.

Mr. S. D. Hopkins and Mr. Bernard Rubenstein, representing the Bernard Lumber Co., appeared and spoke on the subject of a grievance they have because the city will not furnish the material for them to construct a sewer line on the street where they are building 15 houses.

They had a letter from some former city employee which they contended bound the city. After thorough discussion and questioning by council members the council decided that the City Manager and Public Works Director were correct in refusing such contribution.

Mr. A. J. Ploch, County Commissioner, appeared to call the council's attention to the serious need for right of way money for the city to get the benefit of enormous sums which are to be spent by the Federal and State Government on highways. He was told that the council now has a committee working on the matter.

On motion of Mr. Gonzalez, seconded by Mrs. Stevens, the meeting adjourned.

ADDENDUM

At the pre-council meeting, a letter was read by the City Clerk from Overton Brooks, M. C., National Vice President, Rivers and Harbors Congress, inviting the City Manager and delegates to attend the meeting on May 25th in Washington. After discussion it was decided the City Manager should go and also the Mayor Pro-tem and Councilman Scherlen.

At the request of the Fiesta Association it was agreed to award commissions as Alcalde of La Villita to Earl Wilson, columnist who will lead the Fiesta Flambeau; Elmer Wilson, President of the Pasadena Festival of Roses; Miss Barbara Schmidt, Queen of the Festival of Roses; and William Boyd (Hopalong Cassidy). It was agreed that in the future, awards of commissions as Alcalde should be made by the council in session.

The City Manager called attention to the meeting of State City Managers Association on April 26th and 27th. It was agreed that he should attend and also the Mayor Pro-tem and all council members who could do so.

Mr. Russell asked Mr. R. N. White to assume chairmanship of the committee to investigate the Bond Issue question.

A letter from A. F. Grimsinger, Mayor of Karnes City, asking that the City permit the use of an old steam fire engine for a parade celebrating that city's 100th anniversary.

The request was granted after approval of the Fire Chief.

The City Public Service Board was authorized to move certain street lights for the Fiesta.

The Council authorized the issuance of parking permit cards to members of the Planning Commission and such other permanent commissions as advisable.

A letter signed by John E. Zeller, John C. Hoyo and Paul Adams asking the City Council to consider the immediate holding of an election to vote a \$5,000,000 bond issue for right of way purchase. The bond to be issued as Improvement District Bonds.

The Matter was referred to the committee now looking into the advisability of such an election.

The matter of public liability insurance for the proposed ski show at Woodlawn Lake was discussed along with general public liability insurance by Fiesta Association. The matter was left to the City Manager and City Attorney to see that the protection is had.

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A letter from Jack Cassidy asking that he be not considered for reappointment to the Planning Commission was read.

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The City Manager was authorized to use certain equipment and funds to Air condition the council chamber.

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A letter from Cleburne Weilbacher asking additional payment of \$165.00 for doctor bills was read. This man had previously had \$245.00 bills paid due to an accident. Upon certification that this is a final bill its payment was authorized.

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
