AN ORDINANCE **73582**

DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS OF THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD THE 4TH DAY OF MAY, 1991, AND ORDERING A RUNOFF ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 25TH DAY OF MAY, 1991.

WHEREAS, the regular municipal election was held on the 4th day of May, 1991, to determine the Mayor and Council Members of the City of San Antonio for the ensuing term of office of two years; and

WHEREAS, the names of the candidates were submitted, the election was held and conducted and the returns thereof were made, all as required by the City Charter and the laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council met on May 6, 1991, in the Council Chamber at City Hall to canvass the returns of the said election; NOW THEREFORE:

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

SECTION 1. The City Council having convened May 6, 1991, to canvass the returns of the regular City election held May 4, 1991, after canvassing the returns of said election, does hereby find and declare the result of the election to be as follows:

SECTION 2. It is further declared that as a result of said election, the following persons were elected Council Members for two-year term commencing June 1, 1991:

- Frank D. Wing, Member of Council, Place No. 4
- Walter Martinez, Member of Council, Place No. 5
- Bob Thompson, Member of Council, Place No. 6
- Yolanda Vera, Member of Council, Place No. 7
- Bill Thornton, Member of Council, Place No. 8
- Weir Labatt, Member of Council, Place No. 9

and each of them was elected by receiving a majority of all the votes cast for the office for which each was a candidate cast by the qualified voters of the City of San Antonio voting at said election, and they and each of them are hereby declared to be the lawful and duly elected Council Member of the City for the places specified.

SECTION 3. It is further declared that as a result of said election, no candidate for Places No. 1, 10, or 11 (Mayor) received a majority of all the votes for the office for which he/she was a candidate cast by the qualified voters of the City voting in said election, and therefore, no candidate was elected at said election for the office of Member of Council for Places 1, 10, or 11 (Mayor), but that a second or run-off election will

be necessary in order that the candidate receiving the highest number of votes shall have received a majority of all the votes cast for the office for which he/she was a candidate, and said run-off election is hereby ordered to be held on Saturday, May 25, 1991. The two candidates receiving the highest number of votes for such places in the election shall again be voted for at the second or run-off election.
