

AN ORDINANCE

2011-06-23-0579

APPROVING “ALICIA TREVIÑO LOPEZ SENIOR ONE STOP CENTER” AS THE NAME OF THE DISTRICT 6 SENIOR MULTI-SERVICE CENTER LOCATED AT 8353 CULEBRA ROAD IN SAN ANTONIO.

WHEREAS, in 2003, the City/County's Joint Commission on Elderly Affairs (Commission) recommended establishing senior multi-service centers to better serve the senior citizens of San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, the proposed facility in Council District 6 will be the sixth senior multi-purpose center established since the Commission's recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the District 6 Senior Multi-Service Center, located at 8353 Culebra Road, will offer a variety of direct social services, including congregate meals, computer classes, exercise, dance therapy, and health-related services, for seniors age 60 and older; and

WHEREAS, although not a City-owned facility, the lessee has agreed to permit the City to name the facility while it is being used as a District Senior Multi-Service Center; and

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2010, the District 6 Senior Council, comprised of various members of District 6 senior nutrition centers and neighborhood associations, met to determine a name for the District 6 Multi-Service Senior Center; and

WHEREAS, the “Alicia Treviño Lopez Senior One Stop Center” was nominated as the name by the District 6 Senior Council and forwarded to the City of San Antonio for consideration; and

WHEREAS, in coordination with the City Council District 6 office, “Alicia Treviño Lopez Senior One Stop Center” was selected as the proposed name for the District 6 Senior Multi-Service Center; and

WHEREAS, the proposed name was sent forward to the City Clerk and considered by the convened naming committee at a Public Hearing on February 23, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the naming committee approved forwarding the proposed name to City Council for consideration and approval; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. City Council approves “Alicia Treviño Lopez Senior One Stop Center” as the name of the District 6 Senior Multi-Service Center located at 8353 Culebra Road as recommended by the convened naming committee.

SECTION 2. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Chief Financial Officer, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.






