

A RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE USE OF VOTING MACHINES  
IN GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE  
HELD ON MAY 11TH, 1943, EXCEPT FOR  
ABSENTEE VOTING.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That since the Commissioners' Court of Bexar County has heretofore adopted the use of voting machines for all elections to be held in Bexar County, it is, therefore, ordered that voting machines be and are hereby authorized to be used in the general municipal election to be held on May 11th, 1943, in the City of San Antonio; except, however, that voting machines shall not be used for casting absentee votes at such election, but that said absentee voting shall be in accordance with Article 2956, Revised Civil Statutes 1925, and amendments thereto.
