

AN ORDINANCE

MANIFESTING THE INTENT OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO TO COMPLY IN ALL THINGS WITH THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE VI OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964 IN THE EXECUTION OF URBAN RENEWAL PROJECTS TEX. R-39 AND TEX. R-83.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio has entered into Cooperation Agreements with the Urban Renewal Agency of the City of San Antonio for the execution of Urban Renewal Project Tex. R-39 (Central West Area, Project I) and Project Tex. R-83 (Civic Center Project); and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and desire of the City of San Antonio to comply in all things with the provisions of Federal law and the regulations adopted pursuant thereto concerning the prohibition of discrimination in the execution of said projects; and

WHEREAS, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and the regulations of the Housing and Home Finance Agency effectuating that Title, provide that no person shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination in the undertaking and carrying out of urban renewal projects assisted under Title I of the Housing Act of 1949, as amended;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City of San Antonio, acting by and through the City Council, hereby assures and manifests its intent to the United States of America and the Housing and Home Finance Administrator that said governing body will give full compliance to all regulations of the Housing and Home Finance Agency effectuating Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, in the execution of Urban Renewal Projects Tex. R-39 and Tex. R-83.


