A RESOLUTION

DECLARING THE CANVAS AND THE RESULT OF AN ELECTION ON THE 2ND DAY OF OCTOBER, 1951 TO ADOPT A NEW CHARTER FOR THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. Came on this the 3rd day of October, 1951, the day after the election to adopt a new Charter for the City of San Antonio, regularly to be canvassed, the returns of the special municipal election held on the 2nd day of October, 1951, at which election there was submitted to the qualified voters of the City of San Antonio a new Charter for the City prepared by the Charter Commission elected by the voters of the City on May 8, 1951, and as framed and presented by said Charter Commission to the Board of Commissioners of the City on August 9, 1951, as fully set out in the Ordinance ordering said election passed and approved on the 23rd day of August, 1951, and as set out in the Election Notice and Proclamation promulgated by the Mayor on the 24th day of August, 1951, posted at the several voting places in the various precincts in said City and published in the COMMERCIAL RECORDER, As required by law, and the Mayor and Commissioners having met to canvass the returns and to declare the result of said election in the manner provided by law, and after considering, determining and canvassing all matters of facts appertaining, we the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, do hereby find and declare the result of said election to be as tabulated as follows:-

"YES" - FOR the Proposition .....19,062  
"NO " - AGAINST the Proposition .....10,251

2. And it appearing to the Board of Commissioners that said new Charter was submitted and that the special election was held and was conducted as required by the Statutes of the State of Texas and the Charter and Ordinances of the City of San Antonio; and, that at said special election there was cast on the proposition submitting the new Charter, the aggregate number of votes marked "YES" and the aggregate number of votes marked "NO", all as shown by the report and the canvas of said returns by the Board of Commissioners, and said returns having been found to be correct in all respects, it is declared that the Proposition to adopt

a new Charter as set out was adopted by a majority vote of the qualified voters at said election.

3. PASSED, APPROVED AND ADOPTED, this the 3rd day of October, A. D. 1951.
