RESOLUTION

Accepting Fifth Street Bridge, constructed by the Elder Construction Company.
BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the City of San Antonio does hereby accept the work of the Elder Construction Company for erection of the steel spans at Fifth Street over the San Antonio River, as per contract with the City of San Antonio, and in accordance with certificate of the City Engineer dated Nov. 6, 1922, and filed with the Board of Commissioners on this 6th day of November, 1922.

Upon recommendation of the City Engineer the petition of William Delleman for permit to construct sewer on S.Hackberry Street was granted; also petition of Tips Hardware Co. for permit to excavate in Comal Street, granted.

A bid for supplying the City with one Ford Automobile was opened and referred to City Purchasing Agent.

Hearings of owners of property interested in the improvement of St E. Josephine Street, River Avenue to Austin Street, Herff Street, Laredo Street to M.K & T.R.R., Austin Street, Josephine Street to Grayson Street, Pecan Street, St. Mary's to Soledad, Fredericksburg Road, Cincinnati Ave. to Martinez Creek, Woodward Place, Dwyer Ave. to River, Avenue D. Grayson to Josephine Street, were held.
