APPROPRIATING \$12,269.13 TO PAY D. & A. OPPENHEIMER A DEBT ASSUMED IN THE SETTLEMENT WITH THE SAN ANTONIO IRRIGATION COMPANY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That \$12,269.13 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of Judgment & Suits Department, 1933 General Fund, to pay D. & A. Oppenheimer the note dated the 24 of September, 1930, for \$10,000.00 due six months after date, executed by the San Antonio Irrigation Company, which debt was assumed by the City of San Antonio by an ordinance passed and approved on the 30 of May 1932, authorizing the settlement of the controversy with the San Antonio Irrigation Company and creating a contract with Charlotte Cassin, Sidney J. Brooks and Cora Ogden for an easement on Mitchell Lake and other property.
