No. 89 **MC-1031** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$22.21 to pay Gus Gimbel, refund on pool table licenses.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$22.21 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund to pay Gus Gimbel for unearned portion of Billard and Pool Table licenses, the same having been ordered discontinued by State laws.

No. 90 **- 1032** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$3196.26 for weekly pay rolls.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$3196.26 be and is hereby appropriated out of the funds hereinafter named to meet pay rolls for the week ending July 19th, 1919 as follows, to-wit:

No. 91 **- 1033** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$13.61 to pay Mrs Leola H. Garland, taxes collected in error.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$13.61

be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund (the School Boards portion being \$3.36) to pay Mrs Leola H. Garland for erroneous assessment of Lot A 10, C.B.149.

No. 92 *MC-1034* AN ORDINANCE

No. 93 *-1035* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating the sum of \$500.00 in payment of hay and corn purchased from Felix Hermann for feed for animals in street cleaning and garbage departments.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Street Cleaning Department fund in payment of hay and corn purchased from Felix Hermann for feed for animals in Street Cleaning and Garbage Departments.

No. 94 *-1036* AN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Two Hundred and Thirty Four (\$234.00) Dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Zoo Fund in payment of two band concerts held in Koehler Park on July 17th and 20th 1919, band consisting of twenty five musicians.
