

AN ORDINANCE 2009-09-17-0731M

EXPANDING THE NUMBER OF GATES AND REDEFINING THE "PER TURN" CHARGE UNDER THE CITY GATE ORDINANCE; INCREASING THE MOBILE FOOD PERMIT FEE; ESTABLISHING A LATE PAYMENT CHARGE FOR AIRPORT EMPLOYEE PARKING; ESTABLISHING FEES RELATED TO SYSTEM FUEL INSPECTIONS AT SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL; AND AMENDING THE CORRESPONDING SECTIONS OF THE SAN ANTONIO CITY CODE TO REFLECT SUCH CHANGES.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio, as the owner and operator of San Antonio International Airport, has established various fees for its users and it is now necessary to increase certain fees and establish new fees; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. AIRPORT CITY GATE. Chapter 3, Division 1 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas, is amended by adding the following:

Sec. 3-28. City Gate Permit.

The Aviation Director is authorized to issue City Gate Permits to air transportation companies and baggage handling companies for temporary access to airport terminal facilities to off load and board passenger. The Permit and Policy Procedures for use of the City Gate shall be as authorized by City Council from time to time. {Ord. No. 98374 adopted October 30, 2003.}

- (a) City Gate facilities shall include those facilities necessary for the servicing of passengers such as gates, loading bridges, and holdrooms that are not leased to an airline on an exclusive or preferential basis.
- (b) City Gate fees shall be assessed in accordance with the rates and charges paid by signatory airlines under the effective Airline-Airport Use and Lease Agreement unless otherwise approved by Ordinance.
- (c) City Gate fees shall be assessed on a per turn basis.
 - i. For billing purposes, a turn is considered to consist of use of the city gate for 1 hour for domestic flights and 1.5 hours for international flights.
 - ii. Neither an actual departure nor off-loading of passengers shall be a requirement for City Gate fees to accrue. Parking at the City Gate shall constitute use of the City Gate.
 - iii. All overnight parking at City Gate(s) shall be billed at the domestic flight basis (e.g. An aircraft parking at a City Gate for 8 hours shall be billed for eight turns).

SECTION 2. Mobile Food Vending Permit Fee. Chapter 3, Division 8 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas, is amended by adding the following:

Sec. 3-140 Mobile Food Vending Permits.

The Aviation Director may issue mobile food vending permits to persons or businesses seeking to do business at the airport and who have obtained the required permits from appropriate regulatory entities. Permits shall be for a one-year term. Each permit applicant shall be assessed a non-refundable fee of \$200.00 per application. Proof of insurance satisfactory to the City must be provided before a permit is granted. The Aviation Director may impose other permit requirements to ensure the proper operation of airport facilities.

SECTION 3. Employee Parking Fee. Chapter 3, Section 3-42 (5) of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas, is amended by adding the following:

(f) A \$5.00 charge shall be assessed for late payment of employee parking fees.

SECTION 4. Inspection Fees on Aircraft Refueling Vehicles. Chapter 3, Division 7 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas, is amended by adding the following:


Sec 3-122 Aircraft Refueling vehicles.

Aircraft refueling vehicles ("aircraft refuelers") shall be subject to ARFF inspection on an annual basis or as often as deemed advisable by the Aviation Director. (a) The following fees are established in connection with such inspections.

- (a) Initial inspection or inspection to maintain valid inspection decal – no fee
- (b) Reinspection, after initial failed inspection – \$25.00
- (c) Fine for operating without a valid inspection decal – \$500.00

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective on October 1, 2009.



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
