MONDAY, FEBRUARY 17TH, A.D.1919, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Coy, Heuermann, Wright. Absent, Lambert.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

Petition of Citizens for arc lamp at Cunningham St. and River Ave. was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

Proposal of property owners to improve Nebraska Street, from Palmetto to Cherry St.


