Issue Proposed for Consideration


I ask for your support for the inclusion of the following item on the agenda of the earliest available meeting of the Governance Committee:

Consideration of an ordinance amending the composition of the Planning Commission to eleven members, excluding ex-officio members, such that each member is appointed by each Council District and the Mayor.

Brief Background

The Planning Commission is currently comprised of nine at-large members and four ex-officio members. This composition is not necessarily conducive to inclusive representation of all parts of our City. I therefore request the consideration of an alternative model of membership by which each Council member appoints one member to the Commission.



