---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

Petition of F.G.Hernandez, proposing to furnish music at Brackenridge Park was read and referred to Commissioner of Parks, etc.

Petition of Mrs S.E.Kirk for correction of assessment was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

Petition of Bookers Tailor Shop for permit to install gasoline pump and tank was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

Bids for making cash book for City were read and referred to City Purchasing Agent.

Commissioner of Fire and Police made the following recommendations, which were adopted: Eastern Vulcanizing Co. to install gasoline tank 808 E.Commerce St. granted. Vulcanizing Supply Company, to install gasoline tank 430 Garden Street. granted. Army Garage and Auto Co. to install gasoline tank Spofford and Grayson Sts. granted. SECTION ONE: That Madison Square, a plot of ground situated within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, and bounded on the North by Camden Street, on the East by Baltimore Avenue, on the South by Dallas Street, and on the West by Richmond Avenue, be and it is hereby designated as the site or location for the Municipal Auditorium of the City of San Antonio.
