The following resolution was introduced by Commissioner Heuermann and adopted:

## RESOLUTION.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that the City of San Antonio does hereby accept the street paving repairs made under separate contracts dated September 12, 1918, on East Houston street from Alamo Plaza to Chestnut street, Avenue C, between Houston street and Grand Avenue, and on Taylor street from Martih street to Fourth street, the date of acceptance being hereby fixed on January 2, 1919.

Petition of Mutual Motor Service Co. for permit to install gasoline pump and tank at 419 Main Avenue.


