Commissioner Kearny introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll-call, to-wit: Ayes, Brown, Garland Kearny and Steves. Nays, None.

MA-340 AN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

THAT WHEREAS heretofore, to-wit, on or about the 14th day of July, 1914, F.V.P. Ellsworth was nominated and appointed by the Mayor as one of the assistants to the City Engineer of this City under the direction of said City Engineer to exercise such discretions and to perform such duties of a character appertaining to pavements and other work in the streets and public places of said City, or relating to other engineering work of the City, as might be required by said City Engineer, and to receive for such services monthly compensation of Two Hundred and Eight and 331/00 (\$208.33) Dollars; and WHEREAS said F.V.P. Ellsworth thereupon entered upon said employment and has since continued in the service of the City lawfully exercising the duties of said employment, and receiving said compensation therefor, and is now holding over as an employe of the City in such capacity; Now Therefore Be It Further Ordained that said employment and services of said F.V.P. Ellsworth have been heretofore and are hereby in all things ratified and confirmed and said employment shall hereafter continue in effect, as an employment of said Ellsworth and his successors from month to month so long as the Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements may find need of such services and desire to continue such employment, not to extend beyond June 1st, 1917,

This ordinance being of urgent importance for reasons of public necessity apparent herefrom shall take effect from and after its passage and approval.

MA-341 AN ORDINANCE.

Appropriating money to pay Mc C. Shacklett and Mollie D. Shacklett for land for river purposes.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the sum of Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the general fund 1915 to pay Mc C. Shacklett and Mollie D. Shacklett for land taken from and conveyed by them to the City for additional channel and banks of the San Antonio River in New City Block 401, all as per contract and deed; and

that City warrant issue payable to said Mc C. Shacklett and Mollie D. Shacklett.

This ordinance being of urgent importance for reasons of public necessity apparent herefrom, shall take effect from and after its passage and approval.

AN ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That there be and there is hereby appropriated out of the 1915 General Fund, the sum of SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY (\$750.00) Dollars, warrant for which sum shall be made payable to Mrs. Kate M. Caldwell, or C.M. Stone, her agent; this amount of money being part consideration for the conveyance by Mrs. Caldwell to the City of San Antonio of a strip of ground for the sidening of North Flores Street, taken out of Lots Nos. W-6 and W-7, in New City Block No. 766, a perfect description of which strip of ground is contained in the plat on file in the City Engineer's Record Book No. 6 at page 13 thereof. And the City Auditor is hereby directed to deliver the said warrant only after he has been notified by the City Engineer that the said Mrs. Caldwell has signed up for paving in front of her said premises.
