

## MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, AUGUST 14TH, A.D. 1922, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable John P. Pfeiffer, Mayor Pro-tem presiding, and Commissioners Lambert, Rieden, Wright.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

## ----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation:
