

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO.

MONDAY, MARCH 25, 1918 at 4 O'clock P.M.

PRESENT: Hon. Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding and Commissioners Coy, Lambert and Heuermann; ABSENT, Lowther, when the following proceedings were had.

Minutes of the previous meeting were ordered approved.

----- MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS. -----

The petition of Fannie L Halff for permit to build was read and referred to the Building Inspector.

The petition of Citizens for water mains in Theo Avenue was read and referred to the Commissioner of Sanitation Parks and Public Property.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police; Stires Outdoor Adv. Co. for permit to erect two bulletin boards on the vacant lot at the intersection of Avenue E and Houston Street; Jones and Finch for permit to install a gasolene pump and tank at 526 South Alamo Street; Central Fire Co. for permit to install gasolene pump and tank at 314 East of Alamo Plaza.

The following petitions were read and referred to the Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements; Citizens, to have Indiana Street graded from South Olive Street to Dreiss Street; Citizens asking for the improvement of West Woodlawn Avenue; Delaware Punch Co. for permit to extend a Sewer in San Marcos Street; Western Union Telegraph Co. for permit to build a manhole in Houston Street between St. Marys Street and Navarro St.

Commissioner Heuermann read the following resolution which was adopted by unanamous vote towit.

Directing the City Clerk to advertize for bids for the construction of a concrete drive way along the South Side of the Alamo Building.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, that, the City Clerk be and he is hereby directed to advertize for bids for the construction of a concrete driveway along the South side of the Alamo Building, in accordance with plans and specifications prepared by the City Engineer; Said bids to be filed with the City Clerk on or before 4 O'clock on April 4th. 1918.

Appropriating money for pay rolls for week ending March 23, 1918.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, that, the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to issue warrants for the payment of wages to City Day Laborers for the week ending March 23rd, 1918, and that the following sums be and are hereby appropriated out of the several General and Special Funds for that purpose, towit;

The petitions of C.C.Clamp, and of D.A.Mc Askill for correction of Assessment were granted on recommendation of Commissioner Coy, duly seconded and carried.

Upon recommendation of the Plumbing Inspector the petition of R.B. Harper for permission to install a gasoline pump and tank at 127 W.Commerce Street was not granted, due to the fact that it would obstruct traffic at that point;

The petition of Mission Ice Co. for permit to install a gasoline pump and tank at 226 Rivas Street was granted on recommendation of the Plumbing Inspector.

The Building Inspector recommended that the petition of Stires Outdoor Sign Co. for permit to erect a Bill Board at Main Avenue and Locust Street be not granted; and that the petition of the Same party to erect a Steel Sign at the Gunter Hotel, to advance the campaign for the conservation of food, be granted; adopted.

Commissioner Lambert introduced the following resolution, which was adopted by unanimous vote.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, that, the San Antonio Water Supply be and they are hereby directed to lay a water main on Callaghan Street between Labor and Peach Streets.
