AN ORDINANCE **80614**

CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A SPECIAL REFERENDUM ELECTION HELD ON AUGUST 13, 1994; AND OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

**WHEREAS**, on May 19, 1994, the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas (the City) ordered a special referendum election to be held on August 13, 1994, for the purpose of determining whether the resident, qualified electors of the City would approve or reject an ordinance which had been passed by the City Council, being Ordinance No. 80186, of May 19, 1994; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has reviewed and investigated all matters pertaining to this election, including the ordering, notices, election officers, holding, and returns thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council hereby canvasses the returns of this election, at which there was submitted to all resident, qualified electors of the City for their action thereupon, the following:

AN ORDINANCE

APPROVING THE COMPLETION OF THE APPLEWHITE RESERVOIR AS A STORAGE FACILITY FOR NON-DRINKING WATER; PROVIDING THAT THE RESERVOIR WILL BE PART OF A LONG TERM PLAN INCLUDING CONSERVATION, REUSE, WATER TRADES, RECHARGE DAMS AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TREATMENT FACILITY FOR WATER IMPORTED FROM OUTSIDE BEXAR COUNTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

The City Council having convened on August 15, 1994, to canvass the returns of the special referendum election held on August 13, 1994, on the above referenced Ordinance does hereby find and declare the results of the election to be as follows:

Ordinance No. 80186:

AN ORDINANCE

APPROVING THE COMPLETION OF THE APPLEWHITE RESERVOIR AS A STORAGE FACILITY FOR NON-DRINKING WATER; PROVIDING THAT THE RESERVOIR WILL BE PART OF A LONG TERM PLAN INCLUDING CONSERVATION, REUSE, WATER TRADES, RECHARGE DAMS AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TREATMENT FACILITY FOR WATER IMPORTED FROM OUTSIDE BEXAR COUNTY.
