## AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating the sum of \$3,500.00 out of the Street Opening and Widening Fund to pay V.A.Petty for land used, at the corner of Nacogdoches and Fourth Streets.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section one: That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to acquire from V.A.Petty for the consideration of \$3,500.00 all that certain strip of land out of Lot 39, City Block 551, at the corner of Nacogdoches and Fourth Streets, in the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, required for the widening the intersection of Fourth Street and Nacogdoches Street.

Section Two: That the sum of \$3,500.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Street Opening and Widening Fund arising from the proceeds of the 1919 Bond Issue, warrant for which shall be drawn payable to the order of V.A.Petty and delivered upon the execution and delivery to the City of San Antonio of a general warranty deed, approved as to form by the City Attorney, conveying said property to the City.
