

Regular Meeting of the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio.
 March 6, 1917, 2.30 P.M.
 Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at 2.30 P.M.
 March 5, 1917

Present: Honorable Clinton G. Brown, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Garland, Lambert, Kearny and Uhr.

The Mayor suggested that inasmuch as the tax rate for the fiscal year 1916 had not yet been determined, that this meeting adjourn until 2.30 P.M. on March 7, 1917.

Commissioner Lambert introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Brown, Garland, Lambert, Kearny and Uhr:

No. 286 **MB-464** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$60.00 to pay C. Kuppers, for services rendered as City gardener for February, 1917

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that the sum of Sixty (\$60.00) Dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1916 General Fund to pay C.Kuppers for services rendered the City as gardner, having been left off the pay roll of the Park Department for February through error.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.

On motion of Commissioner Lambert, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned until until 2.30 P.M. on March 7, 1917, as previously suggested by the Mayor.
